Out of school club.

At Grand Avenue Primary School Out of School Club, we aim to provide a safe, happy, secure and relaxed environment, offering a range of activities and games to reflect the interests of the children in our care. The Out of School Club is run in the Community room and School hall. Children will also have access to the School facilities during the hours of the club, as well as use of the library, ICT suite, outside areas and School equipment.

Breakfast Club.

Our Breakfast Club is open from 7.30am to the start of School, weekdays during term time. At the end of the morning session, KS1 children will be taken to their class by a member of our team and KS2 children will make their own way to classes. We serve breakfast until 8.15am where children are offered a choice of cereal. Our priority in Breakfast club is to make sure all the children have eaten breakfast and are ready to start the School day. We try to choose games and activities in the morning that encourage a reasonably calm atmosphere and start to their day.

After School Club.

After School Club is open from the end of School until 6pm, weekdays during term time. Children may be collected at any time before 6pm.

Our priority is to ensure that all the children arrive safely at the After School Club. Our team will collect KS1 children from their classrooms and escort them into the club, KS2 children will bring themselves to the club. At After school club the children are given a

light snack, followed by a piece of fruit. An example of the light snack will include Hot dogs, Pizza, Pasta in tomato sauce or Chicken Nuggets with baked beans or hoops. This is followed by a piece of fruit, such as an apple, banana, pear or raisins. We will also have seasonal fruit such as Strawberries or watermelon in the Summer. Our menus are mindful of any allergies or intolerances the children may have. After snacks, there will be a selection of activities and resources available including board games and puzzles, construction toys, dressing up, physical play, outside play including sports, reading and IT. There is also a variety of arts and crafts which are designed to encourage the children's creativity.

All of our staff have experience in working with children and will undertake professional development training. All staff members are DBS checked.

The Breakfast and After School provision is run by the School and therefore adopts the School policies. Please see our website for all the up-to-date policies.
