English and Maths Home Learning

Home learning will be put on Google Classroom each Thursday and is due back the following Tuesday. Remind your child to log-in each week to see feedback on work submitted.

Reading

Your child is expected to read at home every day and the diary signed at least 3 times a week. We ask that you encourage your child to note down what they have enjoyed about their current text, words that interested or confused them and/or a brief summary of the piece they have read. When you sign the reading diary, you may wish to make comments about their reading too.

English	<p>Narrative</p> <p>Recounts</p> <p>Grammar</p> <p>Poetry (Performance)</p>	<p>Your child will be learning about narrative writing, story writing, creating a diary entry and developing character descriptions based on a key text.</p> <p>Your child will be taught how to write a non-fiction piece of writing and we will also explore how to use paragraphs effectively.</p> <p>Spelling, punctuation and grammar will be integrated into our English lessons as well as taught directly.</p>

Topic	<p>Rampaging Romans</p> 	<p>Lessons include Computing: Creating media through animations and programming a sequence Science: Forces and magnets. We will be carrying out enquiries to discover the different types of forces. Art: Examine and discuss work by Georgia O'Keefe. Experiment with colour and a range of collage techniques. Create mosaics. DT: Making Roman bread. Exploring Cultures: Creation stories- Aboriginal, Christian, Islamic, Hindu History: The Roman Empire and the impact it has had on life in Britain. Modern Foreign Language: French Music: Use tuned percussion – glockenspiel PE: Athletics and gymnastics Relationships and Health Education: Loss and separation and emotional, social and mental health.</p>
