Spring Clubs 2026

We are pleased to confirm that a variety of clubs from external providers together with some free clubs run by our own staff will open to children in the Spring Term. **Our extra-curricular clubs programme start w/c 5th January 2026.**

Timetable	The Spring timetable is attached. <ul style="list-style-type: none">External clubs start w/c 5th January and will run until Friday, 20th March. Please see the Spring Clubs timetable for the dates as there are some exceptions to these dates.Staff led clubs will start w/c 5th January 2026.No clubs will run over half-term (16th-20th February 2026), Friday, 13th March (Parent/Teacher consultations)or Friday, 27th March (the last day of the Spring term).Clubs may not run due to trips or ad hoc events. School will let parents/carers know when these are confirmed.
R-Y6 Staff-led Clubs	Staff-led Clubs will run in the Spring term and are free. These must be booked via the School Gateway. Please also note that club bookings are NOT carried over from the Autumn term and these must be rebooked every term. <ul style="list-style-type: none">These clubs will be available to book on the School Gateway from 9am on Friday, 19th December. Please sign in to your School Gateway account and select which club you would like to book. If your chosen club is not showing, this will mean that the club is already fully booked. A wait list for staff led clubs will be operated. Please email the School Office if you would like to add your child to this list.Children can book onto only one teacher-led club. If your child wishes to join any additional staff-led clubs, please email the School Office with your request.Clubs “by invitation” are not bookable. Children are invited to attend the club by personal email.
External Clubs (fees apply)	The external club providers have opened their bookings for the Spring term. <ul style="list-style-type: none">For clubs run by external providers (indicated by * on the timetable) you must apply to the club directly. Please note that bookings are not automatic and you must rebook your space every term. (Goodlife Gymnastics may differ if you have signed up to their rolling enrolment). Important reminders for all after-school clubs	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Children attending the <u>following clubs</u> will be dismissed from the new green gate by the Annex building: Beyond Blocks, Basketball, Football and Home Learning Club (Years 5/6). <i>All other children will be taken to the lower pedestrian entrance gate by their club teacher for collection when their club finishes.</i>• A reminder that children should be collected <u>on time</u> from after school clubs. If there are any changes to your child's collection you must notify the Club provider, the Office and Out of School Club (if applicable). Please notify the club provider if your child will not be attending the club on a specific day.
Action required	<p>Staff-led clubs: Bookings for staff-led clubs will open at 9am on Friday, 19th December. <u>Only one teacher-led club is allowed per child.</u></p> <p>Bookings for external providers are open now. Please remember should you wish to book a club run by external providers, you will need to book with them direct.</p>

We hope to provide an opportunity for all children to participate in extra-curricular clubs and do not wish for any children to be excluded on the basis of cost. If your child is eligible for **Free School Meals**, you are able to apply for one funded place in a club offered by an external club provider. Please contact the School Office who can help.
