Pupil numbers are looking very healthy across the school with some year groups being full

There have been 38 submissions for a place in the Nursery starting September 2025. (There are 52 places available in total). Due to the number of applications the Nursery will need to run two sessions. It was noted that the lower numbers of applications are reflected across the borough. The low birth rate is the main factor impacting this, with this year being the lowest it has been nationally. Mainly this is post covid years and it will take a number of years to increase.

Reception - the number of children applying for the September Reception intake has been high, with Grand Avenue Primary being first choice for the majority of families. The tours and talks which have been running have been very successful. The Early years lead has worked very hard with supporting Early Years.

The school has recently reached it's 90th birthday and some events to celebrate this milestone will be planned for the summer months.

SBM is working on budget

Staff curriculum working party is still ongoing and further sessions were held on the recent inset day.

English - targets on handwriting

Maths - Matt led a session on teaching maths

There was also an ASD training or ADHD training, staff were able to choose the session which best supported the children who they work with.

Question: Will the maths teaching be shared with parents? Response: This will be shared with parents as it is understood that some would find this beneficial.

065 | SEF UPDATE

The SEF has been updated since last time this was sent to Governors. For those new to this the SEF is broken down into differing areas the school need to work on.

Question: What is the safeguarding effectiveness training question for? Response: These are some areas which were flagged as part of the SG audit. E.g.; witchcraft and sorcery. These have been added into the audit and noted as areas where staff should be trained. However, training is not readily available.

AFC are reviewing whether they can add in SG bitesize training to support some of the more specific areas of training requirements flagged in the SEF. A query has been raised with AFC as to whether some of these niche elements suggested should be added into volunteer inductions or not.


