Maths	<p>Multiplication Division Money Measure</p>	<p>We will be developing and consolidating a range of mathematical skills to enable your child to be a confident mathematician!</p> <p>Learning will focus on: Solving multiplication and division problems by grouping or sharing, counting in steps of 2, 3, 5 and 10. How to solve money problems, choose coins to make amounts and give change. How to choose and use appropriate standard units to measure length, height, capacity, mass and temperature.</p>
English	<p>Adverbs Conjunctions Apostrophes Suffixes</p>	<p>Learning will focus on: The class text books - we will be talking about writing in role, writing a diary entry and writing a narrative. We will also be thinking about how different characters in a story might feel and how we can use words for effect. We will explore and develop empathy for a character and write for real purposes and audiences. In addition to this we will look at different suffixes and how these change the meaning of words.</p>
