

## Rules for Children

As part of our school's GRAND Values (Generous, Respectful, Aspiring, Neat, and Determined), these rules are designed to keep you safe, respectful, and focused while having fun. Remember, our parent helpers have given their time to help you, so be kind and helpful to them!



### **Poolside Rules:**

- **Listen carefully to the swim teacher and school staff** – Being **Respectful** means following their instructions to stay safe.
- **Walk slowly around the pool** – Show you're being **Neat** by moving carefully to avoid slips and falls.
- **Keep your hands to yourself** – No pushing or splashing so everyone feels safe and can enjoy the water.
- **Wait your turn and be patient** – This shows you are **Generous** by letting others have their turn and **Respectful** of everyone's time.
- **Be polite to adults and classmates** – Say “thank you” to our helpers and show kindness by using your manners.
- **Change quickly and sensibly** – Try to get changed on your own and as quickly as you can. If you need help, just ask a helper politely!

### **Non-Swimming Group Rules (Outside/Indoor Activities):**

- **Listen to the adult helpers and school staff** – Show **Respect** for the time they have given to help you.
- **Focus on your reading, maths, or English tasks** – Be **Aspiring** and try your best in everything you do.
- **Be kind and helpful to others** – If someone needs help, be **Generous** and offer your assistance.
- **Stay in the location asked of you** – Being **Determined** means following instructions and staying in the right place.
